

CLASS OF 2008

The Class of 2008 consists of one hundred seventy-three (173) young men who were selectively admitted from throughout the greater metropolitan Detroit region. The class includes 11 students who have been recognized by the National Merit Corporation through the National Merit and National Achievement Programs as semi-finalists.

FACULTY

The faculty consists of 55 instructors who hold 2 Doctorate Degrees, 39 Masters' Degrees and 14 Bachelor Degrees.

ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS AND GRADING POLICY

Serious preparation for successful college work requires that the student develop habits of organization, inquiry, perseverance, self-motivation, and independence. The program of studies assumes an interested and serious student.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS: GRADES 9-12

Twenty-two and a half (22.5) credits are required for graduation from U of D Jesuit High School. The credits must include the following:

- 4 Theology
- 4 English
- 3 Mathematics
- 3 Foreign Language
- 3 Social Studies
- 2 Lab Sciences
- 1 Elective
- 1 Physical Education/Health
- 1/2 Speech
- 1/2 Fine Arts
- 1/2 Computer Applications

A half credit in Fine Arts may be waived for students who wish to take all of the following:

- 4 Years of Mathematics
- 4 Years of Foreign Language
- 4 Years of Social Science
- 3 Years of Laboratory Science

One credit in Physical Education may be waived if a student participates in Marching Band for four years while in high school.

SENIOR SERVICE

U of D Jesuit is truly a pioneer in secondary school service programs. For over thirty years, U of D Jesuit students have received weekly classtime to serve in outreach programs throughout greater Detroit. They do so under the guidance of a faculty member and are expected to spend time reflecting and writing papers on the service they are providing.

In 2006-07 school year, U of D Jesuit students took 226 Advanced Placement Exams covering 15 subjects, and scored 3, 4, or 5 on 78% of them.

AP Courses: Art; Biology; Calculus; Chemistry; Computer Science; English; Latin; Modern European History; Physics; Spanish; U.S. Government; U.S. History.

Honors Courses: English II, III; Geometry; Pre-Calculus; Physics; Chemistry; Biochemistry; Spanish II, III.

Honors and AP Courses are WEIGHTED in computing the grade point average.

U of D Jesuit does not employ an academic ranking system for its students. An assessment of a student's relative achievement might be made by placing him in the context of the performance of his class. The chart below describes the academic performance of the class.
